Are you ages 16-19 and in full or part-time further education or training and need help to pay for essential education-related costs?

If you are you may be entitled to a bursary of up to £1,200 per year.

How can a bursary be used?

A bursary can help pay for any education-related costs such as:

- Equipment you might need for your course
- Lunch
- Transport to and from Martec

How much could I get?

You could get a bursary of up to £1,200 per year if you are in one of the following groups:

- In care or care leavers
- Claiming Income Supports / Universal Credit
- Receiving Employment and Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance / Personal Independence Payment

If you aren't in one of these groups, you could still get a bursary depending on your personal circumstances. Ask Lynda Hassall to see if you are eligible.
